REIMPORTATION OF CATEGORY 2 MILK FROM REPUBLIC OF IRELAND

The Department of Agriculture and Rural Development, in accordance with the terms of the above legislation, hereby authorises the re- import into Northern Ireland of:-

Product: Category 2 Milk rejected at the place of destination in the ROI due to excess levels of antibiotics.

From: Approved Dairy Plants in the Republic of Ireland

To: Approved Dairy Plant of dispatch in Northern Ireland

subject to the following conditions:

1. Category 2 milk imported under this licence, must be collected, transported and identified in accordance with Annex II of 1774/2002/EC.
2. During transportation, a commercial document as required by 1774/2002/EC must accompany the category 2 milk. The document shall satisfy the requirements, and be kept for the period, specified in Annex II of 1774/2002/EC. They shall in particular, include the information concerning the quantity and a description of the material and its marking.
3. The category 2 milk must be conveyed directly to the dairy plant of origin in Northern Ireland.
4. The exterior of the transport vehicles must be cleansed and disinfected before leaving the facility in the Republic of Ireland.
5. The licence holder must ensure that the plant of dispatch in the Republic of Ireland advises DARD of the return of the milk by faxing a copy of the completed commercial document to ☎ 028 905 25472.

6. Upon receipt of the returned milk the receiving dairy plant in Northern Ireland must advise DARD within one working day of the arrival of each consignment by faxing a completed declaration as set out in Annex A of this licence to ☎ 028 905 25472.
7. The receiving dairy plant must also return a copy of the commercial document to the dispatching plant in the Republic of Ireland within one working day of the arrival of the consignment.
8. This licence remains valid until unless amended or revoked by the Department.
